Tim Cobb Leadership Award

A new award for 2019, the South Carolina State Association of Fire Chiefs will present the **Tim Cobb Leadership Award** to recognize a Chief Officer (paid or volunteer) who has demonstrated true professionalism and leadership in the state. Chief Tim Cobb was a long-time member of the South Carolina State Association of Fire Chiefs, a dedicated leader in his community, a true professional amongst his peers, and a true friend to the fire service.

The nominee for this award must have made a noteworthy and significant difference in his or her community, region or state relative to the fire and/or EMS service. The nominee shall have achieved significant results towards excellence on a local, regional or state level. This award may also recognize a Chief Officer who has demonstrated commitment to the safety and welfare of the citizens of their community or the personnel in their department or region. The recipient may be career, volunteer, or both.

The nomination must be a written letter explaining how the nominee meets the guidelines set above. All nominations must be mailed to the Executive Director of the South Carolina State Association of Fire Chiefs by July 1st of each year. The Executive Director shall forward nominations to the appointed Awards Committee for review. The Awards Committee will review the nominations within thirty (30) days following the July 1st date to decide who will receive the award.
