The following information shall be included in a binder will be considered your application:

- Provide department name, location (city & county), fire chief, and names of individuals associated with fire prevention program on a cover page.
- Provide a detailed description of your community's fire risk.
- Describe how you identified fire prevention issues within your community.
- Describe your approach to establishing a program on Fire & Life Safety.
- Describe any outside assistance you used in promoting your program (media, etc.).
- Describe any success stories since the implementation of your program such as documented life saves, reduction in fire related issues, etc.
- Provide a list of materials used in the program.
- Describe your methods for obtaining financial assistance and or community support for the program you implemented.
 - Include any photos, videos, news articles, public education materials used, etc.
- Applications will be judged on innovation, creativity, evaluation of program, planning, implementation, community support, media involvement, and program strategy.

Deadline

Completed applications with supporting documentation shall be received before the close of business on July 1st. Announcement of the winners will be made at the Annual South Carolina State Association of Fire Chiefs Conference each year.
